PACKLIST
 Rough and demanding on both the bike and the body. Before you start, have it checked by a qualified bike mechanic. Make sure your bike is in good shape and properly adjusted. Check for damaged or dented areas. Use extra pads to stop your bike while descending. Make sure your seat and seat post are tight. Make sure there is no looseness or play. Check tire condition, with no tears or cuts in the sidewall. Make sure your brakes are tight and unable to spin. Seat and seat post

ability and in such a manner that you can stop or avoid other riders. Stay on marked trails; don't cut switchbacks. Don't make earnings. Don't use or attempt to use a trail or are not visible from above or to other riders. Don't be crossing mountain roads on trails. Don't overtake other riders. Anticipate other users at corners and give way to faster riders as soon as is safe to do so. Don't ride on trails when entering a trail or starting downhill. Don't ride on Winter Park Resort trails. Don't ride if you are involved in or are a witness to a collision or accident. Don't ride if you are under the influence of alcohol or drugs. Don't ride if you lack the physical dexterity, ability and knowledge to safely load, ride and maintain a bike and features you choose. Don't ride if your bike is not in proper working order. Check entire bike daily. Don't ride if you are an employee, other guests, property, and your National Forest.
